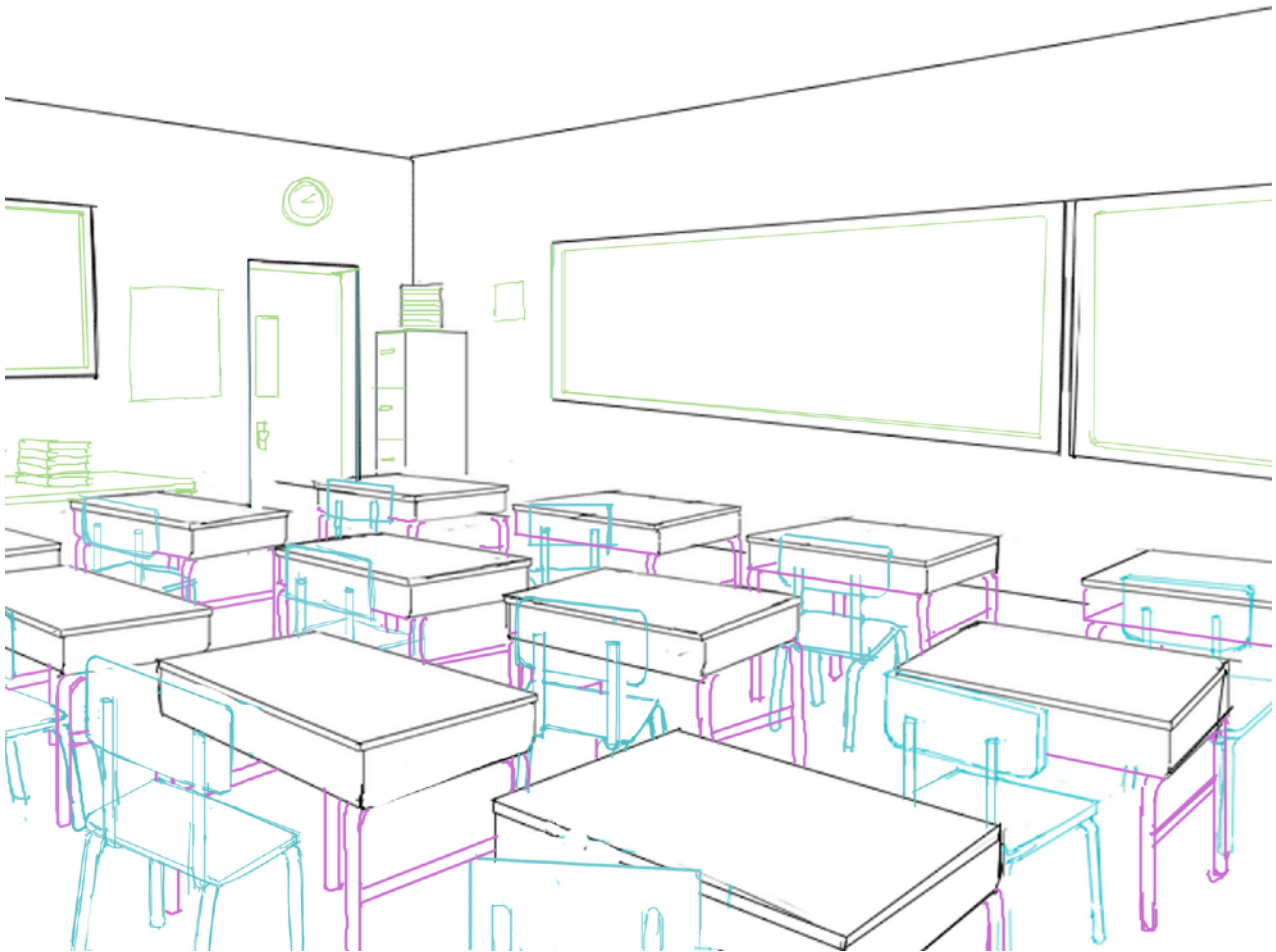


THE SIDE ROW
